

# Classroom Updates

# Math Mrs. Lloyd

Students are continuing to practice multiplying and dividing fractions by whole numbers and mixed numbers. We are also learning to convert measurements using fractions as well. We continue to apply these operations with real world word problems.

I plan on a unit test on all operations using fractions next week.

Students continued to analyze the Constitution completing new missions as Constitution detectives for the FCDAA. The detectives investigated Article 1 of the Constitution: Legislative Branch of government.

### Science Mrs. Lloyd

Continuing on with our study of human body systems, we are wrapping up exploring the circulatory and cardiovascular system. We are looking at the parts of the heart as a muscle and we will begin to exercise(a little bit of zumba) and learn to take our heart rates.

We are presenting a short project on the functions /parts of the circulatory/cardiovasc ular systems using shape poems.

### EL*A* Mrs. Murrell

In Reading, students participated in a day of shared learning where they showcased their knowledge of research through a debate. Students dove into a new research topic with their groups. Students recalled how to research an issue deeply. Students analyzed two sources on their topic comparing and contrasting author's craft.

In Writing, Students brought a critical perspective to their writing by analyzing and explaining evidence. Students redrafted by envisioning how their writing will play out from beginning to end. Students planned out their introductions and body paragraphs mentally before taking pencil to paper. Students learned how to add rebuttals, responses and counterclaims to their writing.
